You will arrive in Zambia and be transported to Silembe, Zambia, where you will stay for 8 days. Silembe is a village of about 100 families that is nearly 90 minutes off the tarmac at Kalomo. There you will live and serve at the House of Faith Orphanage where we are building facilities to eventually serve 72 Orphans. You will then be transported to Livingstone where you will experience Victoria Falls, a one-day safari, shopping, and additional ministry opportunities.

Cost: \$ 2,980 which includes airfare. Team will raise \$ 17,000+ for Home and other projects at the site — See Mission Plan for details.

About Zambia

About 68% of Zambians live below the recognized national poverty line, with rural poverty rates standing at about 78% and urban rates of 53%. Per capital annual incomes are currently at about one-half their levels at independence in 1964 and, at \$395, place the country among the world's poorest nations. Social indicators continue to decline, particularly in measurements of life expectancy at birth (about 40.0 years) and maternal mortality (729 per 100,000 pregnancies). The country's rate of economic growth cannot support rapid population growth or the strain in which HIV/AIDS related issues (i.e. rising medical costs, decline in worker productivity) place on government resources.
